

Fast Track PhD: Crediting of PEF Core Courses to your Master Studies

General

Starting in the fall semester of 2011 the PEF is offering a Fast Track programme to our Master students (MEcon and MiQE/F): Students can shorten their future PEF studies by attending two additional core electives and have them credited to their current Master studies. Together with the already available core courses on Master's level which are compulsory on the PEF level, a minimum of 16 ECTS and a maximum 24 ECTS can be credited to the PEF studies, depending on the specialization. Crediting of the Course Work

The PEF Core Electives will be credited to the Core Studies on the Master's level. After entering the PEF, students may apply for crediting of these previously performed course work after entering the PEF. Please contact the PEF Executive Director.

MEcon:

In the MEcon max. 12 ECTS (8 ECTS Core Electives and 4 ECTS Independent Electives). The remaining ECTS will be credited as "freie Leistungen/additional work".

MiQE/F:

In the MiQE/F max. 12 ECTS (4 ECTS Core Electives and 8 ECTS Independent Electives). The remaining ECTS will be credited as "freie Leistungen/additional work".

Constraints

Between the master's programmes and the PEF schedule organization it cannot be guaranteed that the courses do not collide.

PEF courses generally take place on 6 half-days within 2 weeks. There are no bidding limits on PEF core electives. The opening of courses is limited to the course listed in the att. document. The general rules of crediting course work apply.
