## **In a nutshell...**

Starting with 2024 DOK Students have the **prime opportunity to attend modules offered by the CUSO Swiss Graduate Program in Anthropology** (<https://anthropology.cuso.ch/welcome>). CUSO is a **renowned network of Swiss Universities**, which finances, coordinates and organizes Graduate Programmes and other joint doctoral activities. A **Module is a 2-3 day course** (taking place at a Swiss University) about an **important contemporary theme & theoretical approach** to which **outstanding (international) scholars are invited** to comment on the PhD-students' research and present their own work.

## **Reasons to participate...**

- This is an excellent opportunity to **work with renowned scholars** and **receive feedback to your PhD research**.
- This is a way to **build academic networks with scholars and PhD-Researchers from other universities** (in Switzerland and beyond) in order to **enhance and further develop your career plans**.
- The **travel and accommodation costs are covered**.
- CUSO also offers **regular PhD Meet-ups** (costs covered) to assist you in your PhD process.
- You **can apply regardless of your primary disciplinary orientation**.

## **How it works...**

- You can receive the **Swiss Graduate Programs in Anthropology Completion Certificate** (if min. 5 modules and min. 2 presentations).
- You **don't need to be a trained anthropologist** to participate. Moreover, when you register at CUSO, you can **potentially register for Modules organized by other CUSO Graduate Programmes** (see <https://www.cuso.ch/en/doctoral-programs>).
