How much does it cost to use the Self-Learning Centre?

The Self-Learning Centre is free of charge for students and other members of the University of St.Gallen. For external users, the offer of the Self-Study Centre costs CHF 60 per semester or CHF 30 per month begun.



What am I allowed to take with me into the Self-Learning Centre?

You can bring anything that you need for your language training or test preparation. Food is not allowed in the Self-Learning Centre. Drinks must be closed, as in the library. Jackets and bags must be kept in the wardrobe (lockers and padlocks are provided).



Can I borrow books or CDs from the Self-Learning Centre?

In general, all media in the Self-Learning Centre are intended for use on site. However, it is also possible to borrow media.



I would like to prepare intensively for an exam. Can I reserve a computer workstation, a learning programme or a book in advance?
