The «Intensive Course English for Academic Studies» is the ideal way to prepare yourself for studying in English at university level. Led by Carolyn Skelton and Paul Skandera, the 48-lesson program offers practical English usage and technical language skills.

- The focus is on the skills necessary to complete the Assessment Year successfully, i.e. listening and reading comprehension, academic writing as well as discussion and presentation skills.
- In addition, you will be exposed to a range of texts and vocabulary pertaining to management, business, economics, and law.
- During the course, all students will participate in a group presentation, submit an academic style essay and get individual feedback from the instructor.
